Boychoirs from across Minnesota participating in this day-long festival include the Central Minnesota Boys Choir, Land of Lakes Choirboys, Metropolitan Boys Choir, Minnesota Boychoir, and St. John's Boys' Choir. The festival culminates with a free concert at 5pm in Landmark Center's Musser Cortile showcasing the singers and will feature performances by each boychoir, followed by a joint piece performed all choirs.

## Latest at Landmark

### New RCHS Exhibit, "A Gentle, Kind Spirit Whose Life Was Art" Opens in April

St. Paul was the home of Jean Sanborn Gross -an artist, painter, and printmaker - for almost her entire life. Because of the city's influence and her love of the outdoors, her work as an artist reflects St. Paul and its rural surroundings. In the 1930s and '40s when Jean Sanborn Gross produced much of her public artwork, she was a student at the Saint Paul Gallery and School of Art where she studied with

two fine teachers, Cameron Booth and Lowell Bobleter. This new exhibit will include several examples of Jean's work in various styles and methods. Tools and supplies she used to create these works will also be included in the exhibit in the Ramsey County Historical Society's Gallery on the first floor of Landmark Center. The exhibit will open on April 21, 2011 at 6pm and is free to the public.

## The Schubert Club Museum New Manuscripts on Display

In The Schubert Club Museum's Manuscript Gallery, new displays for 2011 feature letters from composers of the 18th, 19th and 20th centuries. The letters offer a tantalizing glimpse into the lives and personalities of famous figures of the past. Four of the letters, from Mozart, Berlioz, Debussy and Sibelius, relate to the sometimes peripatetic life of a composer trying to earn a living from his art, while letters from Beethoven, Clara Schumann, Ravel and Shostakovich remind us that creative genius provides no exemption from the frailty of the physical body. Letters from Donizetti, Johann Strauss, Dvorak and Bartok hint at the difficulties composers have in disseminating their works—not just in performance but also in print. The Schubert Club Museum is open Sunday through Friday from Noon to 4:00pm. There is no admission charge.
