A Talent to Amuse: An Evening with Noël Coward

Saint Paul, MN - Sundays at Landmark presents Skylark Opera's *A Talent to Amuse An Evening with Noël Coward*, created and performed by Gary Briggie, on Sunday, January 15 at 1 pm. This event is free and open to the public. Join Skylark Opera for an encore performance of this one-man musical tribute to the quintessential British wit, actor, composer and playwright, Noël Coward. The cabaret performance features nearly 30 of The Master's most memorable songs. Inspired by the Las Vegas act which revived Coward's career in 1955, Mr. Briggie interweaves soaring romantic ballads, jazzy dance tunes and hilarious story-songs with wry observations about London, the joys of travel and life in the theater.

Skylark Opera has, since its inception, emphasized both high artistic quality and opportunity for local (Upper Midwest) professional artists (both musical and technical) to exercise their talents in fully-produced works. The company also emphasizes patron accessibility by performing all works in English and by maintaining moderate ticket prices with discounts available for students, seniors, and other selected patron categories.

Skylark Opera's *A Talent to Amuse* is a part of "Sundays at Landmark," an event series produced by Minnesota Landmarks, the nonprofit programming and management agency for Landmark Center. It is located at 75 West 5th Street, facing Rice Park, next to the Ordway Center for the Performing Arts and The Saint Paul Hotel.
