Red House Live from Landmark Center Concert features Blues Artist Cliff Eberhardt on Friday, October 21, 2011

Saint Paul, MN – Blues rock artist Cliff Eberhardt plays a special concert on Friday, October 21st as part of the new monthly concert series "Red House Live from Landmark Center" in the F. K. Weyerhaeuser Auditorium at St. Paul's historic Landmark Center. This series – a collaboration between Landmark Center and St. Paul's own Red House Records label – brings internationally recognized acts to perform at the intimate 230-seat theater. The concert will be hosted by local KFAI radio personality Johnny D, host of "Radio Antilles". The event begins at 7:00 pm with a pre-concert cocktail hour, giving audiences the opportunities to enjoy complimentary refreshments, provided by hospitality sponsor The Saint Paul Hotel, and mingle with both DJ and musicians. The concert begins at 8:00pm. Tickets are \$15 in advance and include admission to the cocktail hour. Cliff Eberhardt knew by age seven that he was going to be a singer and songwriter. Growing up in Berwyn, Pennsylvania, he and his brothers sang together and their parents played instruments. Long one of the most respected songwriters on the club scene, his peers often mine his catalog for themselves. Cliff's song "Memphis" was included on "Cry Cry Cry," an album of collaborative covers by the "folk supergroup" of the same name (comprised of Dar Williams, Lucy Kaplansky and Richard Shindell). Other performers who have recorded his songs include Richie Havens, Shawn Colvin, Russ Taff and Buffy Sainte Marie.
