An Important Update to Landmark Center Community Programs Scheduling Urban Expedition China Postponed, Black Sea Odyssey Made Virtual

SAINT PAUL, Minn. (January 13, 2022) - In an effort to keep Landmark Center's community partners and visitors safe, and due to the recent surge in COVID-19 Omicron cases, several Community Programming changes have been made.
