IRISH CELEBRATIONS

Join Irish Arts Minnesota and Landmark Center during the luckiest time of the year with two family-friendly events. St. Patrick's Day Irish Celebration, a tradition beginning in 1983, is scheduled Friday, March 17 from 10 am-5 pm with non-stop Irish entertainment, kid friendly crafts and activities, and Shenanigans Craft Fair with local food and authentic vendors.
